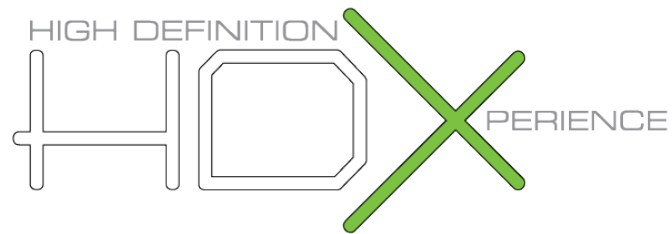


Google Android Apps Installation Guide

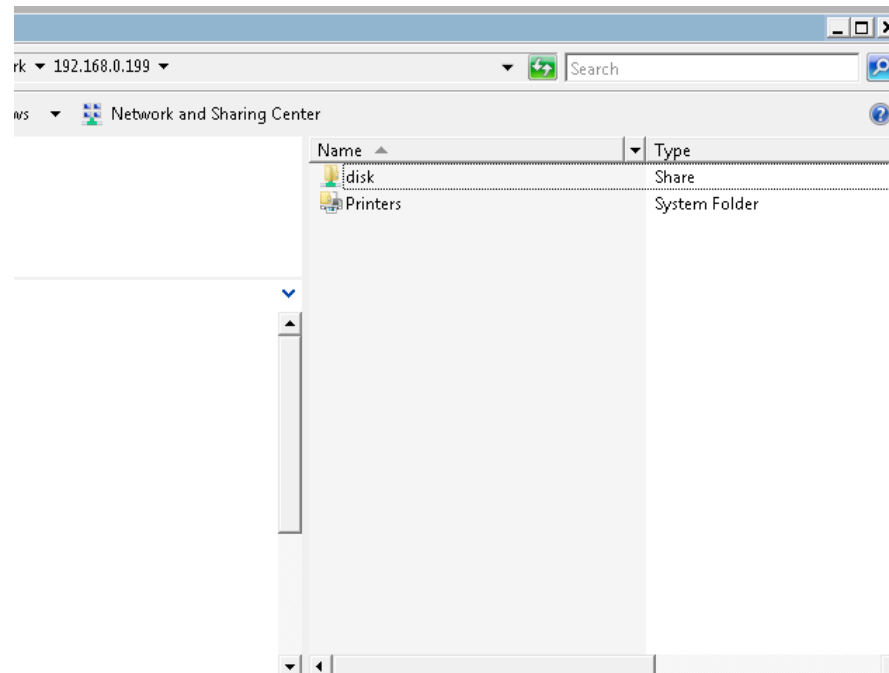


How to install my android apps?

There are 2 options available, which we will explain below.

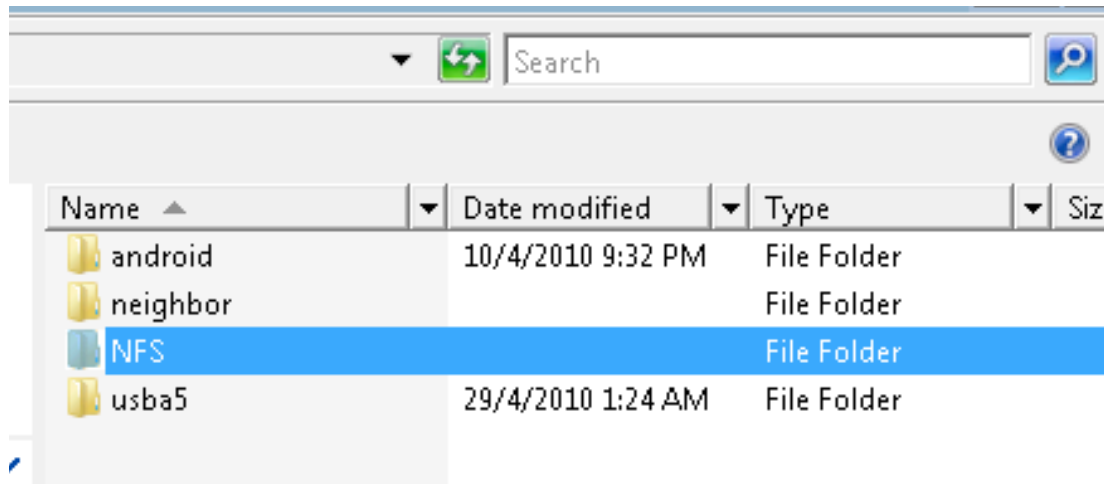
- Via Network

- Power up your HDX Bone, and boot to HDX Voir (it won't work if you are in Android environment)
- On your PC, go to RUN command and enter the IP address of your HDX Bone in the following way. [\\192.168.0.2](http://192.168.0.2) (for example)
- If you see the below window, you have successfully connected to your bone. If not, please verify that your IP address is enter correctly.

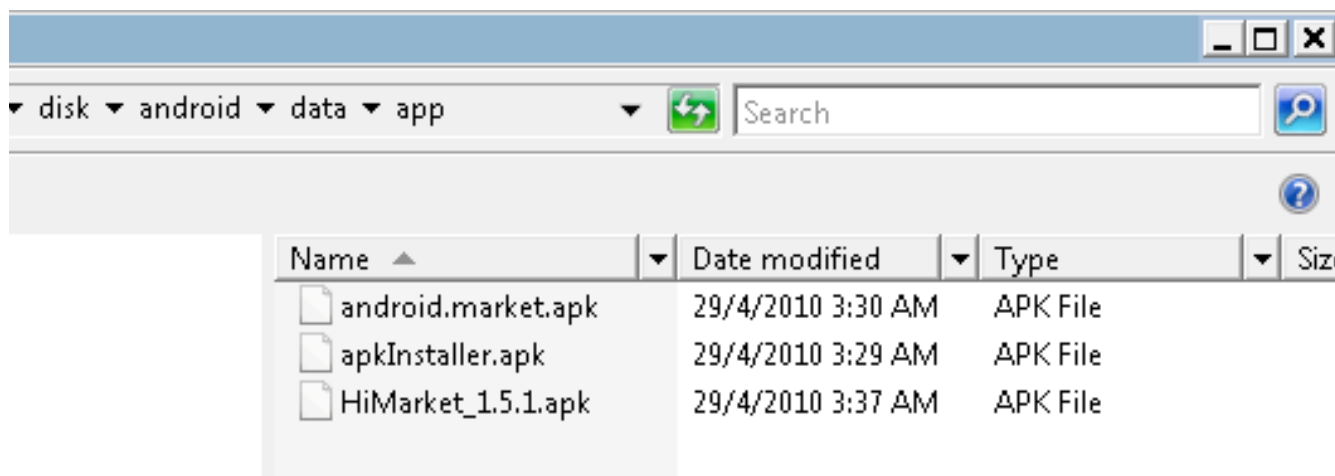


How to install my android apps?

- Depending on how you have configure and install your android, the folder name varies. In this example, we named our android partition as Android as shown below.

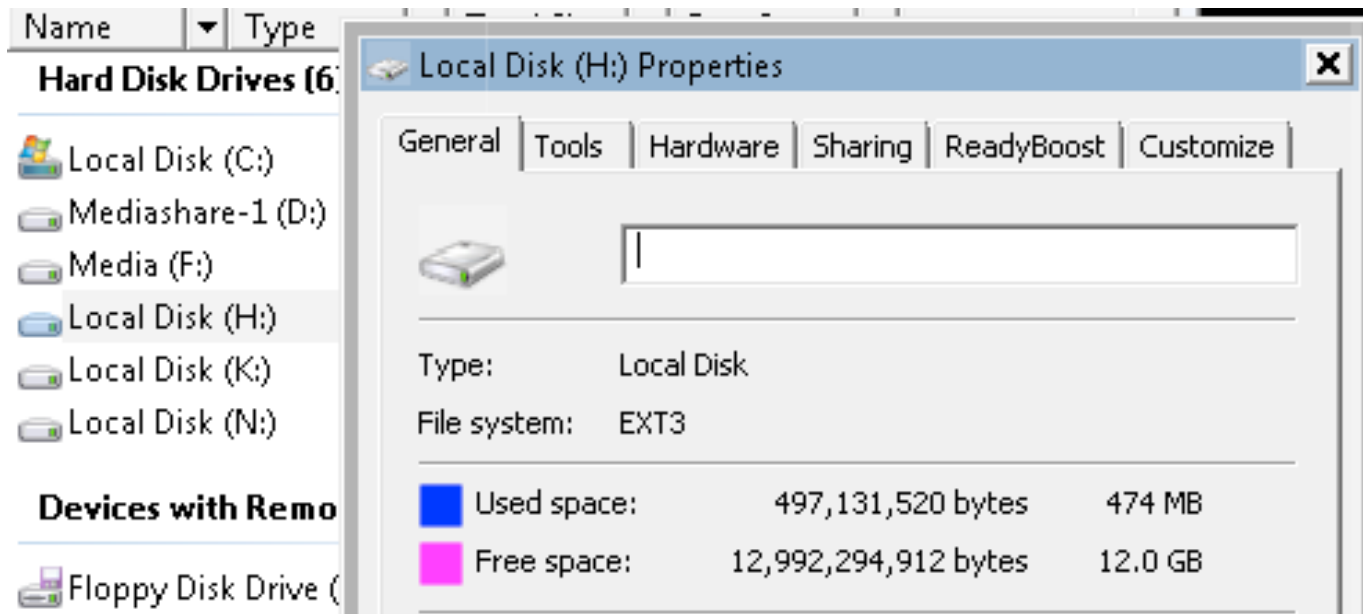


- Access the android folder, and navigate to data/apps (do not temper with the rest of the directory if you do not know what you are doing!). Copy apps to this directory. The installation is complete.



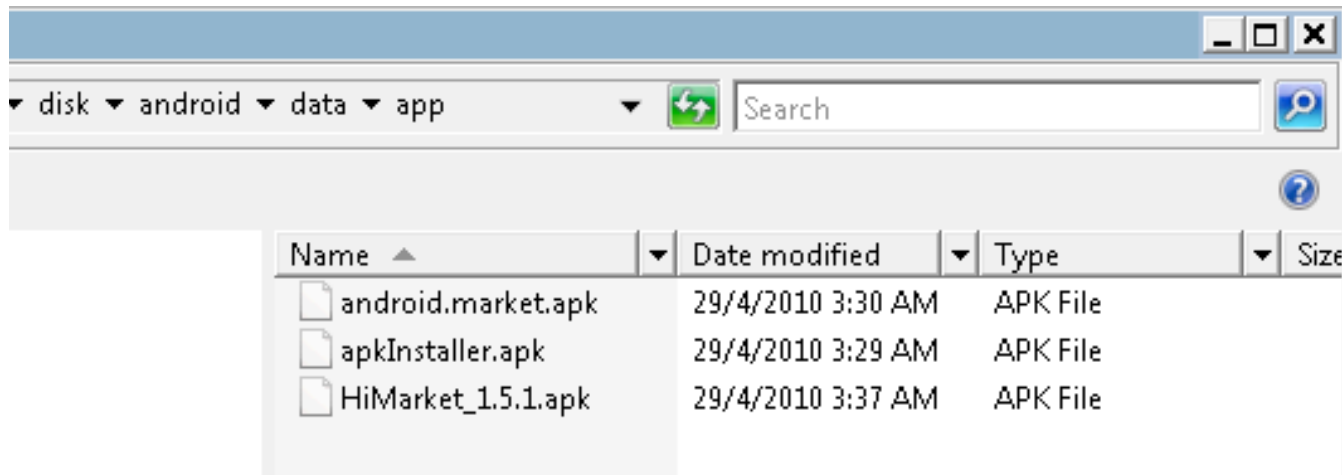
How to install my android apps?

- Via USB
 - Before you mount your HDX Bone to your PC, please ensure that your PC has the ability to read/write a linux EXT3 partition. We recommend installing ext2fds which is a freeware.
 - After mounting the HDX Bone, you are able to access the android partition as shown below.



How to install my android apps?

- Navigate to H: (check your drive letter, may differ) and you can see the android directory. Go-to data/apps and copy the apps to that folder.



- Installation is complete, just start up the Bone and boot to Android. The apps will be install automatically.
